What is it?

GAÏDZ is a USA based charity registered at the IRS as a 501(c)(3) organization. Its founding members and its Board of Directors are entrepreneurs, professionals and scholars. We believe in the essential role that the Classical Armenian heritage played, (beginning with the writings and translations of the Holy Translators during the fifth century) based on the Armenian version of the Bible and its manuscripts, in shaping our identity and culture. Projects

Why GAÏDZ?

- GAÏDZ is the only foundation dedicated to research in the Classical Armenian Bible and its manuscripts and commentaries;
- It is the only non-ecclesial and nondenominational foundation which promotes scholarship and research in the Armenian version of the Bible;
- It is the only foundation dedicated to supporting individual scholars in their research of the Armenian Bible by participation in conferences, publication of books, and organizing conferences on this subject;
- It is the only foundation that reaches out to the younger generation by using the latest technologies to promote reading the manuscripts associated with the Bible and its commentaries in Classical Armenian and publishing them.
- It is the only foundation that is committed to establishing research centers in the USA and around the world, along with its sister organizations in the UK and France, for scholars in the field of the Classical Armenian heritage version of the Bible.
